2022 Headwinds to Events

Sponsors moving away from F&B investment

The 2023 ETE budget takes on \$600,000+ due to CoBank and CFC backing out or reducing their reception and other F&B sponsorships at the Annual Meeting.


2023 Education, Training & Events is no longer member dues supported

The 2022 budgeted amount in dues was a net of \$1,377,000 (\$245K in revenue and \$1,622K in expense).

The 2023 budgeted amount in dues for ET&E is \$0.

F&B and audio-visual expenses have doubled in 3 years (2018-2021)

F&B \$126,000 to \$253,000 Audio-visual \$405,000 to \$746,000





Proposed fee changes are as follows:

- Spouse fees for Regional meetings from \$45 to \$200
- Spouse fees for PowerXchange from \$75 to \$200
- Regional meetings registration fees for 2023 from \$495 to \$549 (early bird) and \$530 to \$599 (regular)
- PowerXchange registration fees for 2024 from \$650 to \$729 (early bird) and \$700 to \$799 (regular)
- Retiree fees from free to paid at PowerXchange
