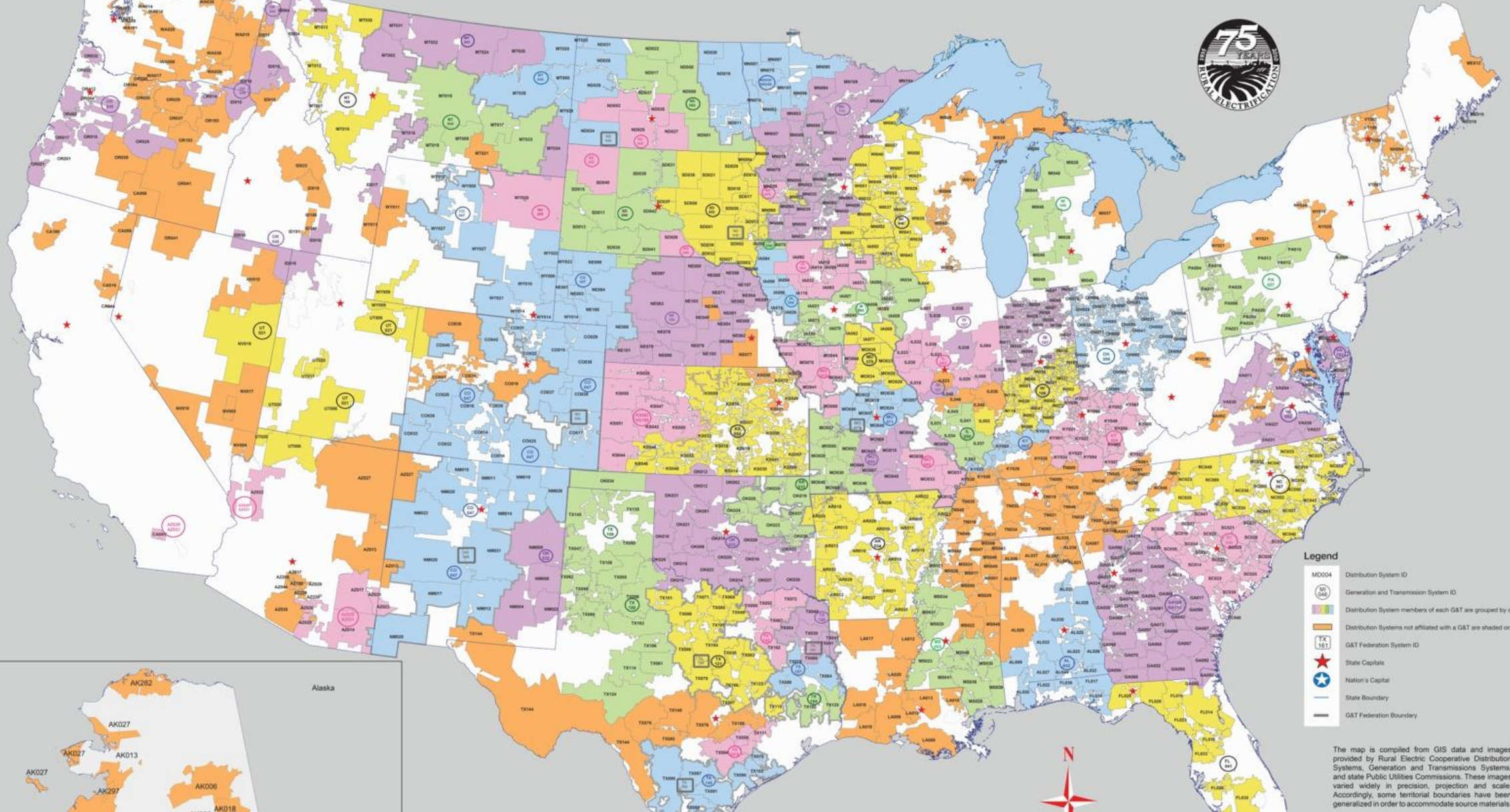

Legend

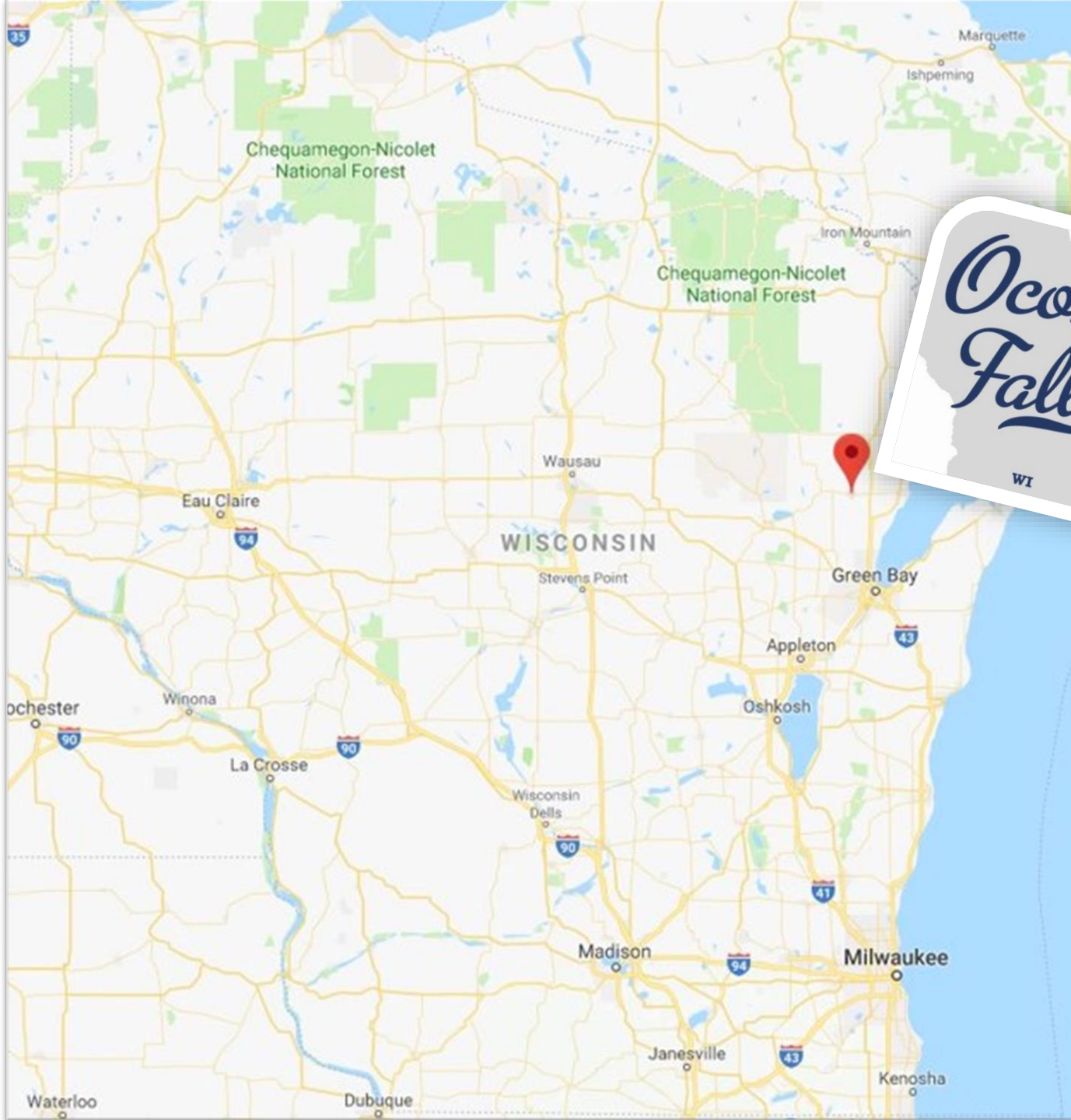
- M0004 Distribution System ID

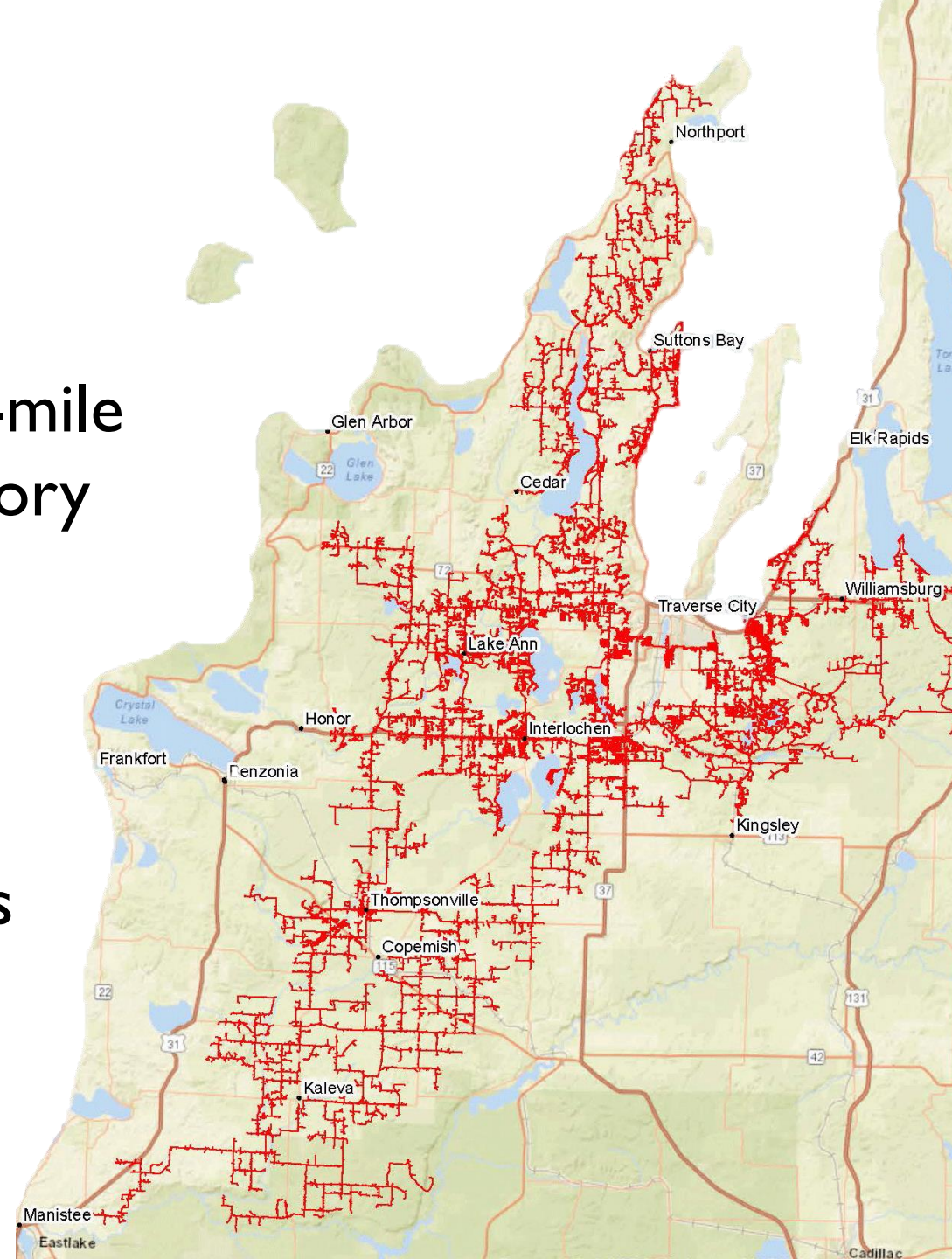

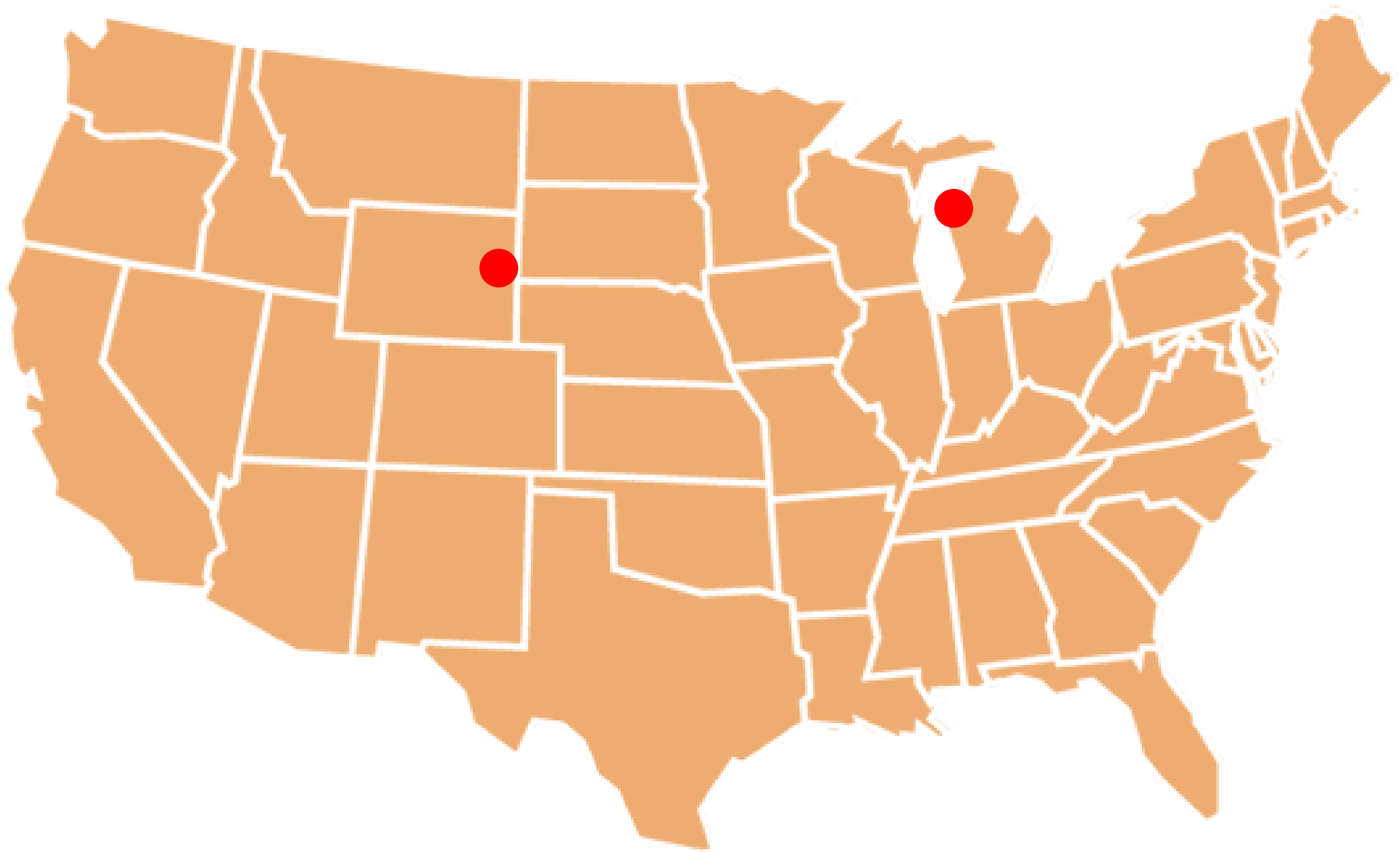
