On behalf of North Dakota's rural electric cooperatives, North Dakota Association of Rural Electric Cooperatives (NDAREC) is seeking emergency restoration assistance rates for the calendar year 2026.

NDAREC is accepting proposal to provide supervision, labor, per diem rates, and equipment to assist in construction, maintenance and emergency restoration assistance for rural electric cooperatives' electrical infrastructure throughout North Dakota. The contract term will be in effect for the calendar year. These rates shall be made available exclusively to the NDAREC and its member-cooperatives, when required, for emergency restoration assistance.

Please provide your company's information on the attached document. Use the attached rate sheet to provide rates for each category of resource and equipment. If you have specific terms and conditions, please attach in a separate appendix. NDAREC will make these rates available to their member cooperatives.

In the event of the request for emergency restoration, North Dakota rural electric cooperatives will review the proposals submitted to NDAREC. They will request assistance, and a contract will be established between the electric cooperative and the contractor responding to aid. NDAREC's Request for Proposal for Storm Rates

This proposal for construction, maintenance and restoration of electrical power will be made available to all members of the North Dakota Association of Rural Electric Cooperatives (NDAREC).

SCOPE OF WORK			
Contractors, responding to emergency restoration, should be prepared to aid the rural electric cooperatives (REC) in the demolition and debris removal of damaged electrical transmission and distribution systems and electrical facilities. Contractors should also be prepared to aid in the repair, restoration and replacement of damaged electrical facilities by replacing broken poles, repairing and replacing conductors to restore power and rebuild the affected electrical system to RUS specifications. The area of restoration will be identified by the effected electric cooperative(s) and defined by North Dakota counties. The scope of work will continue to evolve as the damage assessment adds more information to the damage description and the progress from emergency response to emergency restoration develops.
