

MAYDAY PROCEDURES AND INTAKE FORM

Calling		Instructions: Remain calm and keep the caller calm in order to communicate accurate information in the least
"Mayday"		amount of time. Document information received, use back of document as needed.
1. Secure the scene first	1	Location of incident. Get precise information such as; address, section line, map, nearest pole number, nearest meter
2. Call office "Mayday"		number, county road.
3. Give your name		
4. Give reason for calling		
5. Request assistance needed		
6. Give location of injured		
7. Provide care as necessary		
8. Describe actions taken for the injured	2	Nature of incident. Identify the number injured and describe what happened such as; car accident, electrical contact,
9. Have message read back		crushing, entrapment, etc.

1. Document time of call		
2. Get name of person calling		
3. Location of accident (map, section)		
4. Type of accident	3	Nature of injuries. Are the victims conscious? Breathing? Bleeding? Trapped? Able to moving?
5. Emergency assistance needed?		
6. What's being done for injured?		
7. Read back message		
8. Notify line superintendent		
9. Call emergency assistance		
List Additional Emergency Numbers		
	4	Actions taken. Has 911 been called? Is the scene secured? Is care being provided to the victims? What hazards are present?
